







fig. 1 - 2: Amblypygus dilatatus Ag.




fig 1: Amblypygus diebachii Agamz




fig 6-8: *Echinolampas affinis* Münster





fig 1: *Echinolampas affinis* Münster










fig 5-7: *Echinolampas stüdleri* Ag









fig. 3: Echinolampas subcylindri-




Fig. 1-4 : *Echinolampas vilensis* Des.






Fig. 1-3: Conoclypeus anachoreta Agassiz



Conoelypterus dühensis Ag.






Fig 1: Limnaria insignis Merian





Fig 2: Cyclaster declivis Coll






Fig. 6 - 8: Schizaster archiaci Colleoni
